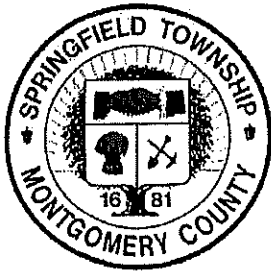

Springfield Township Plumbing Fees:

Master Plumber Registration:

\$70.00 - Annual Registration Fee

\$50.00 - Re-Registration

Journeyman Plumbing Registration:

\$35.00 - Annual Registration Fee

\$20.00 - Re-Registration

Fixtures: All fixtures added, replaced or permanently removed - **\$30.00 Per Fixture**

Sanitary Sewer Repairs/replacement, Water Service Repairs/Replacement or Water Heater Installation/Replacement - \$50.00

NOTE: All work that involves the repair, replacement or connection of the any portion of the sanitary sewer system requires a Master Plumber that is registered with Bucks County Water & Sewer Authority. Proof of registration is required, before any permit will be released.

Pool Pumping Fee - \$10.00 per each \$5,000 gallons pumped to a maximum fee of \$50.00.

Sanitary Sewer Connection Fee per {EDU} Equivalent Dwelling Unit – Please contact Bucks County Water & Sewer Authority for the current rate.
