

Located at the intersection of Elm Street and Mermaid Lane, Mermaid Park is a 7acre passive recreation facility located in the Wyndmoor section of the Township. The park was donated to the Township in 1974 by the United States Department of the Interior.

A substantial park rehabilitation project was completed in October 2022. The revitalization of this Natural Resource Park included dredging of the pond, vegetative streambank stabilization, and the installation of an ADA walking path.



FISHING IN SPRINGFIELD PARKS

With a valid PA Fishing License, patrons of all ages are permitted to fish at Sandy Run Quarry. At Hillcrest Pond, fishing is limited to patrons 15 years and younger or 65 year and older.
