Incidents

9/18/23 – Andorra Road/Northwestern Avenue – Officers responded to a reported theft from a vehicle. The complainant returned from a walk to the rear window of their vehicle smashed and their purse stolen from inside. Officers canvassed the areas for cameras and referred the incident to Detectives.

9/20/23 – Walnut Avenue/Logan Avenue – Upper Dublin – Springfield Officers responded to the area to assist Upper Dublin Police who were in pursuit of an individual in crisis. Upper Dublin Officers requested an “Officer Assist” and several officers from surrounding agencies responded for officer safety and scene control.

9/20/23 – Willow Grove Avenue/Pine Road – While conducting a traffic stop, Officers located a vehicle that had been stopped multiple times for fraudulent registration. Upon further investigation, the paper temporary tag on the vehicle was also fraudulent. Subsequently, the driver was arrested for Counterfeit Documents.

9/21/23 – Church Road/Haws Lane – Officers responded to the area for reports of a black sedan that was driving slowly and drove into a bush. Officers canvassed the area without being able to locate the vehicle. Surrounding agencies were notified of the information in the event similar incidents occurred.

9/21/23 – Paper Mill Road/Montgomery Avenue – Officers were dispatched to the area for a subject that fell into the roadway. After making contact it was determined that the individual was intoxicated. Medical attention was refused, and a non-traffic citation was issued for Public Drunkenness.

9/21/23 – 300 block of Montgomery Avenue – Officers and Detectives were dispatched to the area for a delayed report of a sexual assault. A juvenile victim reported that she was sexually assaulted while waiting for the bus. Due to the intensity of the investigation, no further details can be released by the Detective Division at this time.

9/22/23 – 9400 block of Stenton Avenue – While answering another call for service, Officers located an individual, possibly involved, that was operating a vehicle while under the influence. The individual was arrested and transported to the station for further examination and a blood draw. Charges are pending for DUI and other related offenses.

9/23/23 – 300 block of Penn Oak Road – Officers responded to the area for reports of juveniles riding motorized scooters in the area. Another resident reported they saw someone walking in their backyard with a flashlight. Several Officers responded to the area but were unable to locate anyone. Officers increased their presence and continued looking for anyone matching the descriptions provided.

9/24 – 900 block of Pleasant Avenue/1700 block Willow Grove Avenue – Officers from Springfield and Cheltenham Townships responded to multiple reports of shots fired. It was unclear where the shots were coming from, but several callers confirmed 6-7 shots were heard. After an extended period of searching the area, Officers were unable to locate any scene or evidence of a shooting. It is possible that shots were heard from Philadelphia and their respective districts were also notified.

9/24 – Northwestern Avenue/Andorra Road – Officers responded to the area of multiple vehicles that had windows smashed and items taken. At least 2 vehicles appeared to have smashed windows and had property taken. Officers continued to canvass the area but were unable to locate subjects due to lack of description.
