INCIDENTS

6/10/24 – 1600 block Bethlehem Pike – Officers dispatched to a local business for a reported retail theft in progress. When Officers arrived on scene, the suspects had fled the area, but the merchandise was recovered in the parking lot of the business. An investigation is ongoing to obtain surveillance footage of the incident to identify the suspects.

The business did not wish to pursue any further action and the information was passed along to other Officers in the event another issue occurs.
