6/17/24 – 1800 block Bethlehem Pike – Officers were dispatched to a local business for a report of juveniles throwing water bottles at the store and staff. When Officers arrived on scene, they located the suspected vehicles involved and spoke with the involved parties. Through the investigation, one of the juveniles was in possession of drugs and was taken into custody. The rest of the juveniles were released with warnings for their mischief.

6/22/24 – 1800 block Bethlehem Pike – Officers were dispatched to the area for a reported retail theft in progress. Officers were quickly able to locate the juvenile actor. The business that reported the incident did not want to prosecute, so the juvenile was released to their parents/guardians.

6/23/24 – Stenton Avenue/W. Valley Green Road – Officers conducted on a traffic stop after observing several violations. After speaking with the driver, the Officers noticed signs of impairment. The driver was asked to step out of the vehicle and submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, to which they agreed. At the conclusion of the tests, Officers determined that there were signs of impairment, and the driver was taken into custody for DUI.
