# ON THE COVER

Chiaramonte Park, Oreland



The park was constructed in 2010 as part of a larger neighborhood drainage project. As part of this work, a small tot lot was created to allow families with small children to enjoy recreation and open space within the community. Funding for the tot lot was provided through the Montgomery County Open Space Preservation Program. This park is dedicated to honoring the life of Henry R. Chiaramonte.

In 2021, the Township completed of the Chiaramonte Park Improvement Project which included a new set of swings, the installation of over 2,000 SY of playsurfacing and an ADA accessible path to the park. The improvements were partially funded by a \$72,215 Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

# RECREATION CENTER PROJECT

The Springfield Township Recreation Center Advisory Committee was established in January 2023 by the Board of Commissioners to guide the planning process for the future of the recreation center located at 1200 Willow Grove Avenue in Wyndmoor. Specifically, this committee will explore what renovations would be needed to the existing facilities in order to accommodate the current and anticipated recreational needs of the community OR if the construction of a new facility is necessary to meet the recreational needs of the community. If a new facility is recommended and affirmed by the Board of Commissioners, the Committee will guide the process for designing a new recreational facility at 1200 Willow Grove Avenue.

# FORMER TANK CAR SITE REDEVELOPMENT

In 2015, Springfield Township acquired a 7.8 acre property located at 1725 Walnut Avenue in Oreland to redevelop the site into a public park. The Township is in the midst of finalizing the voluntary Act 2 land recycling program through the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and is currently taking steps to proceed in transforming this former industrial site. In late 2022, Springfield Township was awarded \$25,000 in grants funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) for the creation of a Master Site Park Plan for the 1725 Walnut Avenue property. The creation of a master site park plan will help the community develop a comprehensive vision for the type of park that the Township will construct at 1725 Walnut Avenue in context of its location, natural resources, and visions of the community. The planning process will take place over the course of several months with many opportunities for residents to participate.



### FISHING IN SPRINGFIELD PARKS

With a valid PA Fishing License, patrons of all ages are permitted to fish at Sandy Run Quarry. At Hillcrest Pond, fishing is limited to patrons 15 years and younger or 65 year and older. Fishing is not permitted at Mermaid Park. Springfield Township recommends a daily limit of two fish per person. Trout season will open statewide on Saturday, April 5.
