INCIDENTS:

6/12/25 – Police were dispatched to the Wawa on the 1600 block of Bethlehem Pike for a report of a theft in progress. It was reported that the actors had left the store, and their license plate was provided, along with a description of the juvenile males. Wawa employees reported that this was not the first time that these juveniles have stolen items recently. Officers went to the address attached to the license plate and spoke with the two males, where they admitted to taking the items from Wawa. Both juveniles were charged with theft and referred to the Youth Aid Panel.

6/14/25 - 6/15/25 – The Police Department received and investigated reports of four stolen vehicles that occurred in the late night/early morning hours, two in the Flourtown section, and two in the Wyndmoor section, and in addition, investigated numerous attempts were made to enter additional vehicles. These cases have been turned over to the Detective Bureau and the investigation is ongoing.
