INCIDENTS:

6/26/25 – Springfield Police along with Cheltenham Police assisted the Philadelphia Police Department in attempting to locate multiple vehicles along Stenton Ave. One vehicle became disabled around Auburn Ave and the occupants took off on foot. Cheltenham Police assisted with a K9 track. Officers continued to survey the area but were unable to locate the males and the investigation is ongoing.

6/27/25 – Police were dispatched to a theft-in-progress at Walgreens on the 1400 block of Bethlehem Pike. The manager reported the male had left the store and provided a description and license plate number. The officers checked the area for the male and the vehicle but were unable to locate him. At the store, officers were able to retrieve surveillance footage. The male in the footage matched the Driver's License Photo and registration from the vehicle that fled the scene. The male will be charged with retail theft and receiving stolen property.
