EXPENSES

The PRELIMINARY 2026 general operating budget of \$21,173,124

\$855,937 or 4.2% MORE than adopted in 2025.

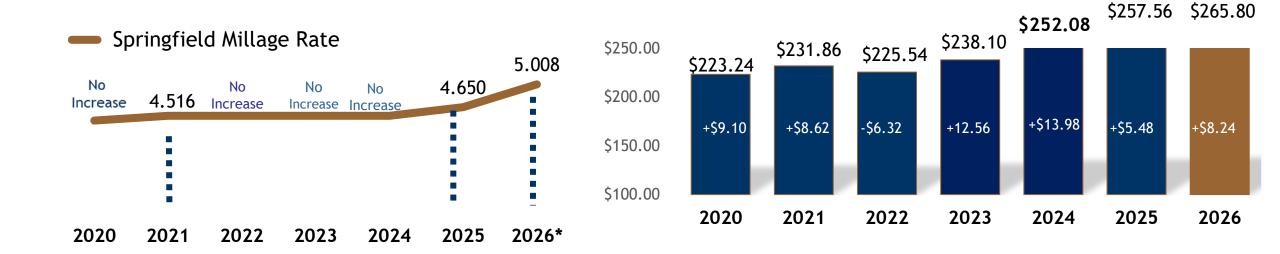
- Attributed to:
 - Increases in public safety wages and equipment, fire protection, employee wages, insurances, library services, parks and recreation expenditures and highway maintenance activities.

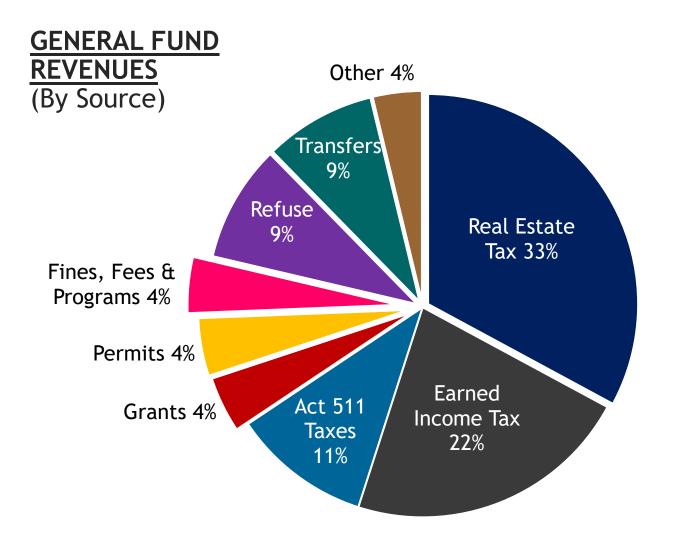

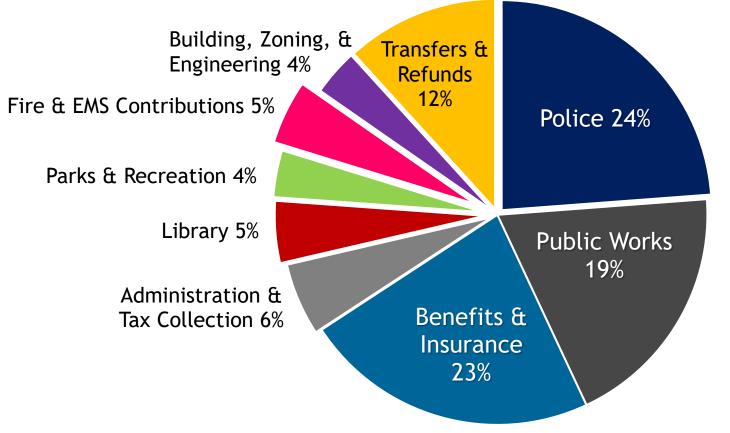
