INCIDENTS:

1/27/2026 – Police were dispatched to a disabled vehicle in the Flourtown Shopping Center. The motorist was stuck in a snowbank and on top of a curb. Police called a tow truck to assist and the motorist mentioned he had just got out of the hospital. His behavior quickly changed, so police also had EMS dispatched to the scene. The vehicle had a flat tire and had to be towed. As police did inventory of the vehicle, they found a firearm. County dispatch confirmed that the driver did not have a gun permit, therefore charges will be filed.

1/27/2026 – Police were dispatched to Springfield Senior Living residences on the 500 block of E Evergreen Ave for a report of theft. The nursing staff reported witnessing a resident go into another resident's room and steal her wallet while she was asleep. Staff found her debit card in the male's belongings. The male was placed in custody for theft, and upon searching him officers found ATM withdrawal receipts. Officers verified that these matched the victim's account.
