INCIDENTS:

2/2/2026 – While on patrol, an officer observed a vehicle come around the bend of Lorraine Ave and Erhenpfort Ave at an unsafe speed. The vehicle was weaving in the roadway at a high speed and hit a snowbank. The officer initiated a traffic stop and immediately noticed the driver had glassy eyes and an odor of alcohol on his breath. The driver admitted to having alcohol and agreed to take the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Due to the driving infractions and results of the sobriety tests, the driver was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.

2/3/2026 – While on patrol at Willow Grove Ave and Queen St, an officer observed a vehicle driving above the speed limit that had a paper tag that was bent, obscuring the expiration date. A traffic stop was conducted, and the passenger was taken into custody for marijuana he had on his person. Officers obtained a search warrant for the vehicle and found more marijuana and a stolen firearm. The appropriate charges for the driver have been filed.

2/6/2026 – While on patrol, an officer was driving behind a vehicle in the area of Haws Ln and Preston Rd that kept driving over the double yellow lines. The car kept making turns, returning to Church Rd multiple times. The officer conducted a traffic stop and the juvenile driver admitted to smoking marijuana earlier. After impairment tests were conducted on the driver, he was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI. The two passengers were given the Preliminary Breath Tests. With a search of the car, the police found a bottle of alcohol. The driver and one of the passengers were charged with alcohol charges and referred to the Youth Aid Panel.
