### INCIDENTS:

2/17/2026 – While at the police station following up with one person involved in a dispute, the other party showed up yelling and requesting a copy of a police report. While speaking, the officer could detect the odor of alcohol on his breath and observed blood shot eyes. The male admitted to driving here and initially agreed to the Standardized Field Sobriety tests. He stopped complying with officers' instructions and was placed into custody for suspicion of DUI. The male pulled away, acted combative, and tried to spin out of the officer's grip while being handcuffed. The male was also charged with resisting arrest.

2/20/2026 – Police were dispatched to CVS on the 900 block of Bethlehem Pike for a theft-in-progress. The county dispatcher advised officers that the male left the store and gave his description. An officer located him at Bethlehem Pike and Montgomery Ave. The male admitted to coming from CVS and stealing products. The male was placed into custody for retail theft. Upon searching him, officers found marijuana and paraphernalia. Appropriate charges were added.

2/20/2026 – While on patrol at Traymore Ave and Willow Grove Ave, an officer observed a sedan drove through the crosswalk as a pedestrian was crossing, failing to yield. The officer conducted a traffic stop and observed the driver to have slurred speech and glassy eyes. The driver admitted to drinking and agreed to the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Due to the violation, sobriety test, and breath test, he was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.
