INCIDENTS:

3/23/2026 – Police were dispatched to the Giant Food Store on the 1800 block of Bethlehem Pike for theft that had occurred. Loss Prevention was able to obtain the car and license plate for the female. Through investigation and security footage, police were able to identify the female. Police issued an arrest warrant and arrested the female for retail theft and receiving stolen property.

3/23/2026 – Police took a report of an assault that occurred. After investigating further, police took a female into custody on the 7700 block of Beech Ln for strangulation and other related charges.

3/27/2026 – Police were dispatched to a domestic dispute on the 2000 block of Paper Mill Rd. The caller reported that a male kicked her out of his car and stole her phone. Police conducted a traffic stop on the male's vehicle. Under further investigation, the male did not take the female's phone and police learned that the female threw a flowerpot at a vehicle during the dispute. The victim provided video footage of this, and the female was then taken into custody for criminal mischief.

3/29/2026 – Police were dispatched to the area of Stenton Ave and W. Wissahickon Ave for the report of a single car crash. The vehicle was on the grass with disabling damage. The driver showed signs of intoxication and was given Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Due to the results of the tests, the driver was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.
