INCIDENTS:

3/31/2026 – While driving on Bethlehem Pike around Stenton Ave, an officer noticed a vehicle tailgating the patrol vehicle and drifting into the center lane. After this continued, the officer got behind the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop. Upon speaking with the driver, the officer could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage inside of the vehicle. After the driver admitted to having drinks, he agreed to the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Due to the results, he was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.

4/2/2026 – Springfield Township Police were dispatched to assist Cheltenham Township Police with a stabbing on the 1000 block of S Easton Rd (Cheltenham). While enroute, a Springfield officer observed a male that matched the description of the suspect. With the assistance of the Cheltenham officers, the male was taken into custody without incident.

4/4/2026 – While on patrol, an officer observed a vehicle running with its lights on the 8200 block of Flourtown Ave in front of a closed business. The officer made contact with the occupants who were all drinking alcohol. The three males were underage and were cited for underage drinking.

4/5/2026 – Police were dispatched to the 9800 block of Germantown Pike for males checking car door handles. The males fled in multiple vehicles before police arrival. Officers observed a car showing signs of attempted theft, and another vehicle that was running and was stolen from a local jurisdiction. The case has been turned over to the Detective Bureau and the investigation is ongoing.

4/5/2026 – While on patrol on Paper Mill Rd near the Route 309 ramps, an officer observed a vehicle driving without lights. Before conducting a traffic stop, the driver opened the car door and yelled something. The officer pulled the driver over and observed abnormal behavior. The driver admitted to drinking and officers conducted the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Due to the driver's behavior and test results, he was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.

4/5/2026 – A vehicle was reported stolen from the 9800 block of Germantown Ave. The vehicle was recovered in Philadelphia.
