INCIDENTS:

5/14/2026 – Police were dispatched to the 800 block of Campbell Lane for a physical domestic disturbance. Police spoke with the male and female parties involved. The female and children showed visible injuries and other evidence from the disturbance. The male was taken into custody and charged with Simple Assault.

5/16/2026 – Police were dispatched to a vehicle crash at the intersection of Willow Grove Ave and Stenton Ave. Upon contact with one of the drivers, officers detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage. This driver was displaying other signs of impairment and admitted to have consumed alcohol that evening. The driver consented to the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Due to the crash, signs of impairment, and results of the SFSTs and PBT, the driver was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.

5/17/2026 – Police were dispatched to the area of Queen St and Ivy Hill Rd for a report of a male who pulled a gun on a subject after a vehicle crash. The male then walked away from the scene. Officers are following up on information related to the involved vehicle, and the investigation remains ongoing.
