INCIDENTS:

7/24/2026 – While on patrol on the 1200 block of Bethlehem Pike, an officer observed a vehicle that was driving without rear lights on and was swerving in and out of the lane. The officer initiated the traffic stop and the driver was attempting to spray air freshener as the officer approached. Due to the smell of burnt marijuana and the passenger admitting to smoking, the driver agreed to the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. The male was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI, possession of a small amount of marijuana and drug paraphernalia.

7/25/2026 – As police were assisting with a medical call on the 2100 block of Carlton Way, and officer observed a vehicle drive down the road with no lights on and no registration plate. The officer conducted a traffic stop and observed an open alcoholic beverage can in the center console and an open bottle liquor in the rear seat. The officer could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage from the vehicle and on the driver's breath. The driver agreed to Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.
