INCIDENTS:

9/7/2026 – Police were dispatched to a robbery in progress at the 7-Eleven on the 1000 block of Willow Grove Ave. Police were advised that the subjects were armed, took money, and fled the store. After obtaining descriptions of the subjects, officers checked the area but were unable to locate them. Security footage was collected, and the case was turned over to the Detective Bureau. The investigation is ongoing.

9/9/2026 – Police took reports of vehicles that were stolen overnight. The investigation is ongoing.

9/9/2026 – Police were dispatched to the 200 block of Roesch Ave for a report of an assault that occurred. Police and detectives spoke with the victim about the assault that occurred. The male was taken into custody later in the day on an arrest warrant for Aggravated Assault, Terroristic Threats, and other related charges.

9/10/2026 – While on patrol on Paper Mill Rd, an officer was behind a vehicle with dark window tint. There was a smell of burnt marijuana and no other cars in front of this one. The officer conducted a traffic stop and spoke with the driver who admitted to smoking earlier. He agreed to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI.
